BRAKE ADJUSTMENT

Check air pressure drop, test parking brake, and check brake clearance.

BRAKE SYSTEM COMPONENTS AND LEAKS

Parking brake and spring brake, if equipped. Hydraulic brake booster & oil change.


STEERING AND SUSPENSION SYSTEMS

Check steering shaft, U-joints, box mounting, pitman arm, and drag link. Steering fluid and axle.

TIRES AND WHEELS

Check tires and wheels, torque lug nuts, and enter existing tire pressure and tread depth.
